

HM Armed Forces Veteran's Hearse Using an Open-Top Bier Drawn by a Black Range Rover



About This Unique Service and Why I Do Not Charge

The closest there is to conveying a coffin on a horse drawn gun carriage, as used at state and ceremonial funerals. This unique method of honouring our military veterans in a procession to their place of interment will leave a lasting memory for family, friends and comrades attending.

A black Range Rover draws an open-top bier on which the veteran's coffin rests draped by a large Union flag especially made for this service by the flag maker to HM Queen Elizabeth II, as in the above photograph, and the British Armed Forces Tri-service crest is on the passenger doors. I have received praise for this service from both The Royal British Legion & my local Member of Parliament.



I deem it an honour to convey a veteran to their place of interment on behalf of a family, and for that reason I cannot accept payment for this service. Instead I ask that a donation is made in the veteran's memory to *Torbay Bikers for Kids* who raise funds to help improve the lives and education of sick, disabled and disadvantaged children in Torbay and the surrounding area. To date, over 100 children have been helped by donations, some of whom had a parent in the British Armed Forces.
